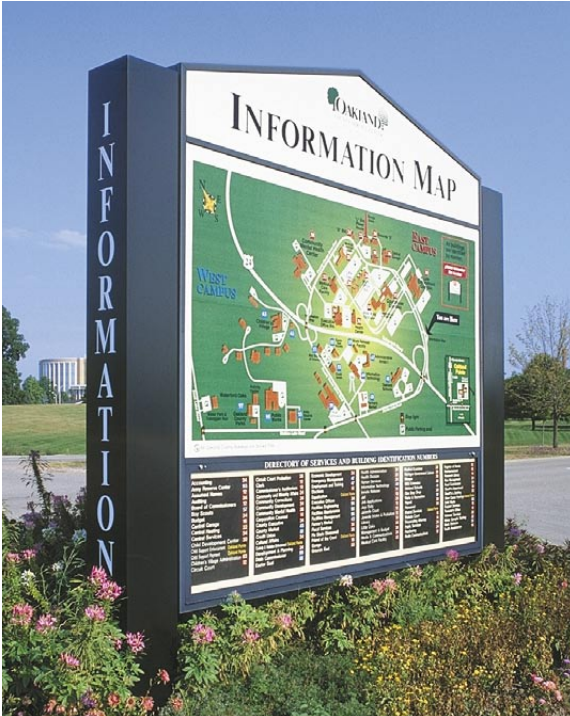


Oakland County Service Center A VALUE-ADDED SIGNAGE RESOURCE



A few miles north of Detroit, on both sides of a major Michigan highway, Oakland County's main Service Center sprawls over 538 acres. The complex's 100+ structures serve more than 30 county departments and total over 1.5 million square feet of interior space. The buildings include courthouses, a jail, medical clinics, a credit union, executive offices, childcare facilities, and more.

On a campus this immense, signage issues arise nearly every day. These challenges involve far more than just sign maintenance; in fact, the Service Center has required value-added signage consulting on an ongoing basis.
